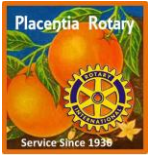

#### **Program Summary:**

Jim Paddock presented a summary of the District Grants that our club applied for and the requirements that needed to be fulfilled in order to receive any District Designated Funds. He explained that there is a specific deadline and timeline that needed to be followed for the application process. The two projects that we submitted on the District website are the Stop Hunger NOW! and Get on the Bus. Our for the Stop Hunger Now! Project is to use the matching grant to enable us to supply 21,776 meals to children in need.

As for the Get on the Bus Project the main goal is to bring children and their guardians/caregivers from the State of California to visit their mothers and fathers in prison. Our hope is to fund one busload of children and their caregivers starting from Orange County to the California Vacaville Prison.
