Program Summary:

Mayor Scott Nelson first gave an update on the OC Bridges Project. He explained the construction and traffic impacts, detour information, and business and community outreach that have taken place prior to and during the construction. The Placentia and Kraemer underpasses are expected to be finished by the first quarter in 2014.

Mayor Nelson stated that the city revenues were 29 million and our expenses are 30.4 million. He expects revenues to increase in the future. Mr. Nelson then spoke of the future parking structure and metro platform. Finally Mr. Nelson spoke about how the city is working towards fiscal sustainability.
