**Kim Jones - Troop 723**

Troop 723, The Screaming Eagles, is a long-established troop in the Placentia area, having been formed in 1963. Kim Jones originally became involved with Scouts in 2005, with Troop 723 in 2012, and now serves as the District Advisor. She proudly states that her son, now 25-years old, attained the rank of Eagle Scout.



What was formerly known as the Boy Scouts of America is now known as BSA, as the organization now includes girls, although under separate troops. The mission of BSA is to prepare youths aged 11 thru 17 in leadership, citizenship, character development, and physical & mental fitness. In all activities, safety is the key focus for both the scouts and the adults supervising them.

The Troop has the only Honor Guard in OC, and provides their service at a multitude of events in the area. The Troop also sets US and Star of David flags at Memorial Park in Fullerton, and Nixon Library. The Fallen Heroes Memorial at El Dorado High was established by a member of the Troop, and is now maintained by the Troop. The Placentia Canine Memorial Wall at Civic Center is also attended by the Troop.

Troop 723 meets on Tuesday evenings at Placentia United Methodist Church, which also provides for the storage of the Troop's
