## **Roy Jefferson - District Governor**

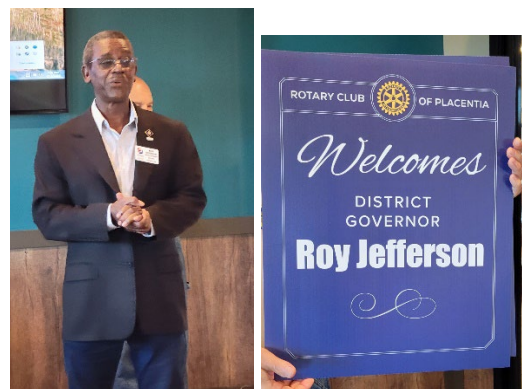
This year, our club was one of the first to host the new District Governor for his official visit. Roy Jefferson is a member of the Anaheim Hills club, and has been a Rotarian for 31 years. He and Janice have

been married for 38 years, raising 2 children: son Chris is an emergency medical helicopter pilot, and daughter Joanna is a dentist. Roy is a 40-year agent with State Farm Insurance.

He has been able to enjoy world travel, including participating in Rotary International projects such as Polio Plus. As a youth, he recalls one of his pastors talking about Hansel & Gretl, and leaving bread crumbs - leaving markers or a trail of influence. Roy likens Rotary programs, and participation in them, to leaving our own mark in the world or the community. He encourages to be actively involved in club, district, and RI projects. Roy also urged us to make The Rotary Foundation our charity of choice. Out of 50 clubs in District 5320, only 66 persons are PH Society Fellows! Roy's goal is 100 additional PH Society members by the end of his term.

We should work with our City Council to do likewise, and work with Kiwanis, Soroptimist, Lions etc.
