Last week's Program

Dr. Alex Cherniss Supt of PYLUSD

Our new Superintendent of PYLUSD is Dr. Alex Cherniss, who took office about 6 months ago, prior to the end of last school year. He is a product of OC, raised in Seal Beach, then attending UCSB. He currently resides in Los Alamitos, where his 3 children attend school (K, 3rd and 5th grades). Dr. Cherniss has served in various educational capacities in the San Marino, Beverly Hills, and Palos Verdes School Districts, after an early desire to

coach sports. He also has a passion for math and finance.

Dr. Cherniss' goal for PYLUSD is to empower teachers and staff to reach and uphold the highest standards. He has found that PYLUSD is much larger than his most recent stint (at PVUSD) with 23,000 students, 21 elementary, 6 middle schools, and 4 high schools, and quite diverse. He has learned that Placentia is a "generational" community – people tend to live, work, and school here, remaining in or near the area over multiple generations.

Other observations and goals:

- build enrollment, despite to overall decline within California
- Stategy/approach: build up Preschool, rather than private school alternatives, e.g. Wagner, Bryant Ranch, 6 others
- Get up to grade-level in English and Math, e.g. provide free afternoon tutoring
- Due to coVid, kids didn't write, practice hand-writing - these are important Life Skills
- Focus on safety protocols for students



Dr. Cherniss is also a Rotarian! He was originally with the San Marino USD, and transferred to Palos Verdes. He is planning to transfer to our Placentia club, possibly along with his executive team . We have, of course, advised him that we do have various levels of corporate memberships available, which might suit his vision.
