CAL-AIM is a recent state program/goal Which will provide enhanced case management and initiative programs, with a goal of attaining sustained housing, to stop the homelessness cycle.



Key staff members include Nayalli, who works with Spanish-speaking women and at bi-lingual events. Christopher is focused on outreach to seniors, marketing at the community senior centers, servivce clubs, etc. Leanne helps track and organize house needs and donations.

HIS-OC has recently begun new fundraising activities: golf tournament, car show, and Christmas tree show.
Charity Closet continues to be a supportive arm to their efforts.

How can interested parties help? Their Wishlist includes grocery gift cards and gas cards, which help with food

deprivation and transportation issues. Hands-on projects include helping with routine wear & tear of the housing - roof repairs, painting and the like.
